

<u>Accessible Parking Advisory</u> Fine Minimum \$150

Dear Driver:

This symbol identifies facilities that are accessible to people with disabilities. When you see this symbol on a parking space on public or private property, please be thoughtful of others. Do not use an accessible space if you do not have accessible license plates or an identification placard.

In Salt Lake City, the minimum fine for parking illegally in an accessible space is \$150 (ordinance 12.56.550).
