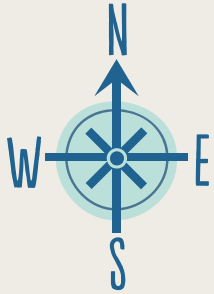

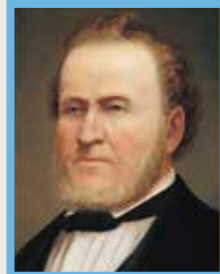
PRESIDENTS OF THE CHURCH

JOSEPH SMITH, JR.

1st President
Served 1830-1844
Buried in Nauvoo, Illinois



BRIGHAM YOUNG

2nd President
Served 1847-1877
Buried in SLC, UT.



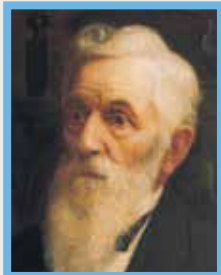

3rd President
Served 1880-1887
Obelisk marker near
330 North. Great

also seen from here.



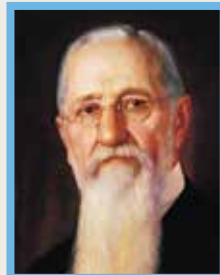

4th President
Served 1887-1898
Several monuments

made from cement.



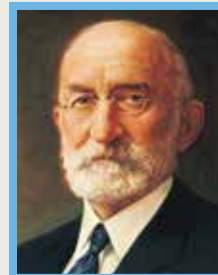
LORENZO SNOW

Served 1898-1901

Flat ledgerstone near
the large Hyrum Smith

Centrally located, this
tall, black granite

8th President
Served 1945-1951
Atop a staircase to a
family area, this flat

9th President
Served 1951-1970
A large monument
made from a slab of
granite is easily seen
in this hillside section.

10th President
Served 1970-1972
Rectangular upright
memorial in Smith
family area notes
service as President.



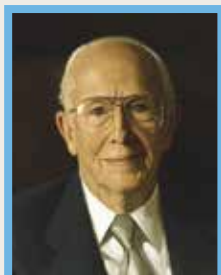
