1300 South Bridge Update - March 19, 2015



Construction is underway on the 1300 South Bridge

Construction began on Monday morning. Please stay away from the construction zone for your safety. The bridge will be fully closed for the duration of construction for safety and to shorten the schedule. Construction is expected to finish Fall 2015.

Businesses in the area are all open and access is provided.



Upcoming work for the next week

- Installation of a false deck to protect railways during construction
- Removal of the bridge deck and overhangs
- Repairs on the columns and other items under the structure
- Signal work at the 700 West intersection will begin early next week. **Please watch for traffic shifts.**

Project Overview

This project is located on 1300 South in Salt Lake City between 500 West and 700 West and will include the following improvements:

- Major bridge rehabilitation including full deck replacement
- Bridge widened three feet
- Other needed structure repairs and improved seismic performance
- Improved pedestrian and bicycle safety/access
- New signal and intersection improvements at 1300 South and 700 West
