

# 1300 South Bridge Update - August 5, 2015




### 1300 South Bridge open to traffic

The 1300 South Bridge that stretches from 500 West to 700 West is open to traffic, two months ahead of the estimated construction schedule.

Salt Lake City and UDOT saw an opportunity to open the bridge early to reduce impacts to drivers and pedestrians travelling in the area. Drivers can expect intermittent lane closures during off-peak hours throughout the remaining construction period.

Please stay away from the construction zone for your safety.

Businesses in the area are all open and access is provided.

## **Project Overview**


This project is located on 1300 South in Salt Lake City between 500 West and 700 West and will include the following improvements:

Major bridge rehabilitation including full deck replacement Bridge widened three feet Other needed structure repairs and improved seismic performance Improved pedestrian and bicycle safety/access New signal and intersection improvements at 1300 South and 700 West
