

Construction Beginning Mid-March



1300 South 500 West to 700 West BRIDGE REHABILITATION

We anticipate the closure of the 1300 South Bridge beginning March 16, 2015. The bridge will be impassable for 6 months. Please stay out of the construction area for your safety.

Project Overview

The 1300 South Bridge over the railroad tracks from 500 West to 700 West will be closed for approximately 6 months.

Improvements will include:

- Major bridge rehabilitation, including full deck replacement
- Bridge widened three feet
- Other needed structure repairs and improved seismic performance
- Improved pedestrian and bicycle safety/access
- New signal and intersection improvements at 1300 South & 700 West
