Come meet the contractor and project team at an Open House for the construction of the 1300 South Bridge Project.

Project Overview

Construction will begin this Spring. The 1300 South Bridge over the railroad tracks from 500 West to 700 West will be closed for approximately 6 months.

Improvements will include:

- Major bridge rehabilitation, including full deck replacement
- Bridge widened three feet
- Other needed structure repairs and improved seismic performance
- Improved pedestrian and bicycle safety/access
- New signal and intersection improvements at 1300 South & 700 West

Construction Details

1300 South Bridge Closure: The bridge will be closed for the duration of construction for safety and to shorten the schedule.
