- 3. Appeals process: Any person aggrieved by any decision of the Historic Landmark Commission may appeal that decision to the Salt Lake City Land Use Appeals Board within thirty (30) days after the Historic Landmark Commissions final decision.
- 4. Meeting notices: Meetings notices are made available 14 days in advance. If persons wish to submit written comments they should be directed to the Historic Landmark Commission at least 7 days in advance to enable the Commissioners to consider those written comments.
