SUMMARY OF ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE HISTORIC LANDMARK COMMISSION AT THE DECEMBER 3, 2008 MEETING.

The following summary of actions by the Historic Landmark Commission is being provided to you for information purposes only. No action by the Administration or Council is required at this time.

<u>PLNHLC2008-00528, Minor Alteration</u>—a request by Jeff Davis, contractor, for minor alterations to a residential building located at approximately 210 North State Street in the Capitol Hill Historic District. The applicant is proposing a change to the roofline, a partial new roof and the repair of brick and stucco. The property is located in City Council District 3, represented by Council Member Eric Jergensen. (Staff: Robin Zeigler, 535-7758, robin.zeigler@slcgov.com)

Decision: The Commission approved the appeal request but conditioned approval of the roofline change upon the applicant presenting staff with accurate drawings illustrating how the proposed roofline change will affect the front end gable. This change must meet staff approval. If the roofline change does not meet staff approval, the applicant may come back before the Commission with an alternate request to address the internal gutter issue.
