Public Hearings

PLNHLC2011-00214, 545 East 900 South, Certificate of Appropriateness for Major Alterations – a request by Mark Loewen for major alterations to a significant contributing structure located at 545 E 900 S. The proposal is to construct an approximately 1,308 square foot attached garage addition to the primary residence as well as other minor alterations to the subject property. The subject property is located in the RMF-30 (low-density multi-family residential) zoning district in Council District 4, represented by Luke Garrott. PLNHLC2011-00390, 876 East 4th Avenue, Certificate of Appropriateness for Major Alterations – a request by James Carroll, architect, for major alterations to a single family residence located at 876 East 4th Avenue, Salt Lake City. The request is for an addition to the rear of the property, increasing the current roof height to the rear to create accommodation on two levels. The property is located in the Avenues Historic District and the SR-1A (Special Development Pattern Residential) zoning district, in City Council District 3, represented by Stan Penfold.
