As part of the review, the applicant is requesting Commission approval of an additional 15 feet of height over the allowed 35 feet. The purpose of the structure is to provide accommodation facilities for families dealing with major medical issues. The site is located within the South Temple Historic District, and is within the RMF-35 (Moderate Density Multifamily Residential) zoning district.
