Re: Salt Lake City Historic Landscape Project

The Historic Landmark Commission will be briefed at the April 7th meeting on the Salt Lake City Historic Landscape Project. The briefing will be for the purpose of learning about the project that is underway. This will give the HLC the opportunity to ask questions and give comment about the project. There will be no action to be made at this time.

Salt Lake City Historic Landscape Project

The Planning Division, with help from the Salt Lake City Parks and Public Lands Program, has contracted Landmark Design to prepare individual histories, inventories and historic landscape Design guidelines. The project is comprised of 38 sites that include certain parks, park strips, cemeteries, golf courses, and other historic open spaces that have historic features or are historic landscapes (please see attached list of sites.)

This project started on July 1, 2015 and the consultants have 18 months to complete the work. The project should be completed by early 2017.

Purpose

The purpose for the Historic Landscape Project is to provide information needed to make informed decisions on design, maintenance, or other use changes that may occur in the future.

Currently historic surveys and design guidelines do not include historic landscapes and yet from time to time the Planning Division and the Historic Landmark Commission will review historic landscapes that are either within Local Historic Districts or are Landmark Sites.

The inventories and histories will help provide information that describes the relationship between natural and cultural resources and the guidelines will help the appropriate decision makers make decisions that are consistent and educated.

Process

Consultants have met quarterly with the Planning Division and Parks to provide an update on the progress of the project. A quarterly meeting with the consultants, Planning and Parks Divisions will keep happening until the project is completed.

Consultants completed so far:

- Conducted field work during summer and early fall
- Site photography (first run)
- Gathered existing materials and resources such as historic drawings, reports, master plans, etc.
- Met with groups, such as city departments, SHPO, etc., that have information about the sites in question.

Approval

Once the project is completed by the consultants, Planning staff will take the project through the approval process. The histories and inventories are a part of this project that will not require approval; it will be used as background information for the "Design Guidelines for Historic Landscapes." The design guidelines will require recommendations from the Historic Landmark Commission, Planning Commission and adoption by the City Council.
