Recommended Motion Consistent with Staff Report Analysis & Findings (Deny Demolition) -

Based on the analysis and findings listed in the staff report, information presented, and the input received during the public hearing, I move that the Historic Landmark Commission deny the request for a Certificate of Appropriateness for Demolition of a Contributing Principal Building in an H Historic Preservation Overlay District. The requested demolition fails to substantially comply with the standards of approval in 21A.34.020.K.1 as only one of the five standards for demolition have been met.

Motion to Approve (Not Consistent with Staff Recommendation) -
