Multiple Property Documentation Form: Historic Latinx Resources in Utah, 1776 to 1942

Motion for a positive recommendation:

Based on the information in the memorandum provided by staff and the attached National Register of Historic Places Registration Form, I find that the Mexican Branch LDS Meetinghouse, located at 232 West 800 South, and the Multiple Property Documentation Form: Historic Latinx Resources in Utah, 1776 to 1942 appear to meet the National Register criteria and I move that the Historic Landmark Commission forward a positive recommendation to the SHPO for the listing of the Mexican Branch LDS Meetinghouse and Multiple Property Documentation Form: Historic Latinx Resources in Utah, 1776 to 1942.

Motion for a negative recommendation:

Based on the information in the memorandum provided by staff and the attached National Register of Historic Places Registration Form, I move that the Historic Landmark Commission forward a negative recommendation to the SHPO that the Mexican Branch LDS Meetinghouse and Multiple Property Documentation Form: Historic Latinx Resources in Utah, 1776 to 1942 should not be listed on the National Register of Historic places.
