This amendment also includes the removal of the Appeals Hearing Officer term limits. The proposed regulation changes will affect sections 21A.06.030 Planning Commission; 21A.06.040 Appeals Hearing Officer; and 21A.06.050 Historic Landmark Commission of the zoning ordinance.
