AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 10-9-303 AND 304, <u>UTAH CODE</u>

<u>ANNOTATED</u>, 1953 AMENDING THE OPEN SPACE MASTER PLAN, CORRIDOR MAP

ONE, [BONNEVILLE] SHORELINE TRAIL.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Salt Lake City, Utah has held public hearings before its own body and before the Planning Commission and believes it appropriate to adopt an amendment to a portion of the Open Space Master Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Salt Lake City, Utah:

SECTION 1. That the Open Space Master Plan, Corridor Map One, [Bonneville] Shoreline Trail, recommended for adoption by the Salt Lake City Planning Commission on April 3, 1997, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby adopted pursuant to Sections 10-9-303 and 304, <u>Utah Code Annotated</u>, 1953 as amended. The City Recorder is hereby directed to retain three certified copies of the amended Open Space Master Plan, Corridor Map One, [Bonneville] Shoreline Trail attached hereto.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its first publication.

AREA CONNECTION

A number of privately owned parcels contain areas that are set aside as Open Space Easements. These areas are important in

that they provide visual open space even though their function is limited.
