

Notification of a Project in Your Neighborhood

Salt Lake City has received a request from Austin Lundskog representing RED Partner Ventures to construct a self-storage development at approximately 134 South 700 West. The property in question is outlined in yellow in the map below. The project is being reviewed as a Planned Development and is also undergoing Design Review. It is located within the Gateway Mixed Use (GMU) Zone. The project would face onto 700 West. (See site plan for more information.) The project must meet all provisions of the Zoning Ordinance unless they are permitted to be modified by the Planning Commission.

This type of development requires special approval from the Planning Commission before a building permit can be issued. A public hearing with the Planning Commission has not been scheduled. You will be notified of the public hearing at a later date.

The purpose of this notice is to make you aware of the proposed development and let you know how you may obtain more information about and comment on the project early in the review process.
