- 2 For the purposes of this title, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

- 4 DAYCARE, CHILD: Persons, associations, corporations, institutions or agencies providing on a
- 5 regular basis care and supervision (regardless of educational emphasis) to children under
- 6 eighteen (18) years of age, in lieu of care and supervision ordinarily provided by parents in their
- 7 own homes, with or without charge, are engaged in providing child "daycare" for purposes of
- 8 this title. Such providers and their facilities shall be classified as defined herein and shall be
- 9 subject to the applicable provisions of title 5, and title 9, this title, and applicable State law.
- 10 DAYCARE CENTER, ADULT: A nonmedical facility for the daytime care of adults who, due
- 11 to advanced age, handicap or impairment, require assistance and/or supervision during the day
- by staff.
- DAYCARE CENTER, CHILD: An establishment providing child daycare to five (5) or more
- children at any one time of any age separated from their parents or guardians.
- 15 DAYCARE, NONREGISTERED HOME: "Nonregistered home daycare" means a person who
- uses his/her principal place of residence to provide child daycare for no more than four (4)
- 17 unrelated children.
- 18 DAYCARE, REGISTERED HOME DAYCARE OR PRESCHOOL (SMALL): "Registered
- 19 home daycare or preschool daycare (small)" means the use of the provider's principal place of
- residence to provide child daycare for up to eight (8) children.
- 21 DAYCARE, REGISTERED HOME DAYCARE OR PRESCHOOL (LARGE): "Registered
- 22 home daycare or preschool daycare (large)" means the use of the provider's principal place of
- residence to provide child daycare for nine (9) to sixteen (16) children.
