

1 **21A.62.040: DEFINITIONS OF TERMS:**

2 For the purposes of this title, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

3 ...

4 DAYCARE, CHILD: Persons, associations, corporations, institutions or agencies  
5 providing on a regular basis care and supervision (regardless of educational emphasis)  
6 to children under ~~fourteen (14)~~ eighteen (18) years of age, in lieu of care and  
7 supervision ordinarily provided by parents in their own homes, with or without charge,  
8 are engaged in providing child "daycare" for purposes of this title. Such providers and  
9 their facilities shall be classified as defined herein and shall be subject to the applicable  
10 provisions of title 5, and title 9, ~~chapters 9.08 through 9.20, 9.28 through 9.40, and title~~  
11 ~~14, chapter 14.36 of this Code~~, this title, and applicable State law.

12 DAYCARE CENTER, ADULT: A nonmedical facility for the daytime care of adults who,  
13 due to advanced age, handicap or impairment, require assistance and/or supervision  
14 during the day by staff.

15 DAYCARE CENTER, CHILD: An establishment providing child daycare and  
16 maintenance to ~~seven (7)~~ five (5) or more children at any one time of any age separated  
17 from their parents or guardians.

18 DAYCARE, NONREGISTERED HOME: "Nonregistered home daycare" means a  
19 person who uses his/her principal place of residence to provide child daycare for no  
20 more than ~~two (2)~~ four (4) unrelated children.

21 DAYCARE, REGISTERED HOME DAYCARE OR PRESCHOOL (SMALL): "Registered  
22 home daycare or preschool daycare (small)" means the use of a the provider's principal  
23 place of residence to provide ~~educational or child~~ daycare ~~opportunities~~ for up to eight  
24 (8) children ~~under age seven (7) in small groups. The group size at any given time shall~~  
25 ~~not exceed eight (8), including the provider's own children under age seven (7).~~

26 DAYCARE, REGISTERED HOME DAYCARE OR PRESCHOOL (LARGE): "Registered  
27 home daycare or preschool daycare (large)" means the use of the provider's principal  
28 place of residence to provide child daycare for nine (9) to sixteen (16) children.
