# **Project Information** Design Review – Building Height over 65'



### What is the request?

The petitioners, Jason Malaska and Jon Galbraith of CW Urban, are seeking Design Review approval to redevelop the property located at 624-636 South 300 West with a 102-unit apartment building that has lobby/leasing space and parking on the first floor, an additional floor of above grade parking, and five floors of residential units. The applicant is requesting a Design Review by the Planning Commission to allow for height over 65 feet in the D-2 zoning district. The proposed height is 85 feet.

## What are the next steps?

The site of the proposed request is within the Downtown Community Council, is adjacent to Central 9<sup>th</sup>, and less than a block from Ballpark. The public hearing date has not yet been scheduled. Mailed notices for the hearing will be sent approximately two weeks in advance to property owners and residents within 300 feet of the development.
