Application: PLNPCM2021-00970– Conditional Use for the Weigand Hall Emergency Overflow Homeless Shelter - Volunteers of America, on behalf of The Roman Catholic Bishop of Salt Lake, the property owner, is requesting Conditional Use approval for an emergency overnight homeless overflow shelter at 235 S Rio Grande Street. The proposed overflow shelter would be located within the existing Weigand Homeless Resource Center, a daytime center operated by Catholic Community Services. This proposal would allow a nightly winter overnight shelter with approximately sixty (60) beds to be operated within that facility on a temporary basis, from date of approval until approximately April 15, 2022. The subject property is located within the D-3 – Downtown Warehouse/Residential District. The use is allowed in the D-3 zoning district as a Conditional Use. The subject property is located within Council District 4, represented by Ana Valdemoros.
