### TEXT AMENDMENTS to RMF-30 - LOW DENSITY MULTI-FAMILY **ZONING DISTRICT**

The City is considering amendments to update the Multi-Family Residential (RMF) Zoning Districts, starting with the RMF-30: Low Density Multi-Family District, with the intent of implementing the Growing SLC: A Five Year Housing Plan (2017-2021) that calls for the removal of zoning barriers to housing development. Staff has found zoning standards in the RMF-30 district in particular can be restrictive and impede creative housing solutions. Therefore, text amendments are being proposed to the RMF-30 zoning district standards that involve:

- Introducing design standards for all new development.
- Allowing the construction of new building forms including cottage developments and side oriented row houses without special approval.
- Reducing some lot width and area requirements to align with existing development in the City.
- Allowing more than one building on a lot and the creation of lots without street frontage.
