DOWNTOWN AND SUGAR HOUSE CONSTRUCTION TEXT AMENDMENT

A request from the Salt Lake City Mayor for a text amendment to mitigate impacts to citizens and neighboring businesses within the downtown and Sugar House areas by allowing for flexibility of certain regulations while a building is under construction. The proposed ordinance seeks to maintain vibrant urban areas during construction by allowing for flexibility of existing standards regarding the placement and use of items such as construction trailers, storage yards, temporary signs, etc. A previous ordinance addressed many of these issues but expired in 2015. The City is now seeking a permanent solution. Planning is of the opinion that the proposed ordinance would most naturally be incorporated into the zoning code as a new section of the Temporary Uses chapter (21A.42). The proposed changes would be in effect across various zoning districts.
