Petition 410-08-04, Westminster Science Building Conditional Use for Additional Building Height—A request by Westminster College, represented by Curtis Ryan, for a conditional use for extra building height located on the campus of Westminster College at approximately 1840 South 1300 East. The proposed new building, located immediately north of Converse Hall, would house the college's science program and would be 75 feet tall. The property is located in an I Institutional Zoning District where the maximum height limit is 35 feet.
