PLNPCM2010-00229: Salt Lake Clinic - A request by INC Health Services, Inc. for a zoning map amendment to change the zoning at approximately 333/349/365 South 900 East and 911/933/937 + 959/963 East 400 South from I (Institutional), RMF-45 (Residential Multi-Family) and CC (Commercial Corridor) to UI (Urban Institutional). The applicant wishes to reconstruct the Salt Lake Clinic in a more urban form in Council District 4 represented by Luke Garrott.

2. PLNPCM2009-00346: Zoning Map Amendment A request by Mayor Becker to amend the Salt Lake City Zoning Map for properties south of OC Tanner between 2000 South and 2100 South and between State Street and Main Street. The proposed Map amendment would change the current zoning from Business Park (BP) to Residential Mixed Use RMU-45 and Commercial Corridor (CC) to Residential Mixed Use RMU zone.

Decision: The Commission forwarded a favorable recommendation to the City Council regarding changing current zoning from Business Park (BP) to Residential Mixed Use RMU-45 and a negative recommendation to changing current zoning from Commercial Corridor (CC) to Residential Mixed Use RMU zone.

3. PLNPCM-00376: Zoning: Text Amendment— A request by the Salt Lake City Planning Commission for a text amendment to grant the Historic Landmark Commission the authority to initiate petitions to amend the Zoning Ordinance and Zoning Map relating to historic preservation issues. This is a citywide policy issue affecting all City Council Districts.
