PLNPCM2010-00072 Odd Fellows Hall Historic Landmark Site Re-designation A request by the Administration for re-designation of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows Hall located at approximately 26 W Market Street as a Landmark Site on the Salt Lake City Register of Cultural Resources. The petition is for a zoning map amendment to re-list the Landmark Site, formerly located at 39 W Market Street, at its new location. This requires the Planning Commission to forward a recommendation to the City Council. The property is zoned D-1 Central Business District and is located in City Council District 4, represented by Luke Garrott.

Decision: The Panning Commission forwarded a positive recommendation to the City Council.

2. <u>Proposed Regional Sports Complex</u>. The Planning Commission will receive a briefing and discuss with staff various zoning issues relating to the proposed community recreation center (regional sports complex) to be located at approximately 2223 North Rose Park Lane.

3. <u>Civic Campus / Public Safety Building and Emergency Operation Center.</u>—The Planning Commission will receive a briefing and discuss with staff various aspects of the proposed Civic Campus area including the proposed Public Safety Building and Emergency Operation Center to be located at approximately between 400 South and 500 South and 50 East and 350 East (former Barnes Bank building and adjacent lots to the south).

4. North Temple Boulevard Viaduct Station Area Plan. The Planning Commission will receive a briefing and discuss with staff the public draft of the North Temple Viaduct Station Area Plan.
