<u>Woodmen Mixed Use</u> – a proposal from Lynn Woodbury, in behalf of Woodmen Properties LC, for a new development located at approximately 2120 S 1300 East. The proposal is to construct a six story mixed-use building that will include 41 residential dwelling units, approximately 15,579 square feet of commercial office space, and approximately 13,677 square feet of retail space. The proposal also includes a parking structure that contains 266 parking stalls. The property is zoned CSHBD-1 Sugar House Commercial Business District. The property is located in City Council District Seven, represented by Søren Simonsen. The proposal requires review of the following four related petitions:
