1. Geronimo Shop Conditional Use and Planned Development - Marco & Melynda Geronimo, property owners, are requesting to change the use of 1330 S 700 W from residential to commercial. The applicants would like to demolish the existing single-family dwelling to give room for an office/retail building, and to repurpose the existing accessory structure into a warehouse. The subject property is located in the R-1/7000 (Single-Family Residential) zoning district and the Transitional overlay district. In the Transitional Overlay District, the proposed commercial uses may be allowed through the Conditional Use process. The applicants are also requesting Planned Development approval to accommodate two principal buildings on the same lot, allow additional signage, and reduce setbacks and special landscape requirements for the existing structure.
