1. **Kozo House Design Review Modifications at approximately 633 West 200 North** - Bryce Baker, representing the property owner, is requesting modifications to a Design Review that was approved by the Planning Commission on December 2, 2020. The approval was granted a one-year extension on November 10, 2021. Since that time, the applicant has modified the design. In accordance with section 21A.59.080 the proposed modifications require approval from the Planning Commission. This project is located within the TSA-UC-T (Transit Station Area-Urban Core-Transition) zoning district located within Council District 3, represented by Chris Wharton.
