
WOOD WINDOW REPAIR AND WEATHERIZATION WORKSHOP

The repair and restoration methods will include: Safe Paint Removal, Glazing, Putty Repair and Replacement, Weather-Stripping, and Sash Re-Installation.

Each workshop offers an intensive hands-on restoration experience.
