

CITY ARTS GRANTS

The City Arts Grants program was established to make financial support available, primarily on a matching basis, to organizations and programs within the City that merit public support. Among the criteria considered during the review and approval process are artistic quality, matching funds from a broad range of sources, payment of professional fees to artists, quality of the application, and accessibility for the general public and underserved populations. After extensive review of many applications, the City Arts Council has made the following 2013-2014 grant awards:

GENERAL SUPPORT grants assist arts organizations with general operating expenses and the continuation or expansion of arts programming for the citizens of Salt Lake.
