General Requirements

- 1** This development requires the submittal of a recorded subdivision plat.
- 2** This development requires the submittal of a completed building permit application along with 2 complete sets of plans, stamped by a Utah State licensed architect or engineer, which includes the following:
 - a** A vicinity map with north arrow.
 - b** The identification and description of the work to be covered by the permit for which application is made.
 - c** The number of cubic yards being brought into the site, where applicable.
 - d** The tax parcel number and legal description.
 - e** The property lines along with the dimensions of each.
 - f** All existing and proposed public way improvements and access points.
 - g** Grading plans with grades shown at a minimum of 2 ft intervals (existing with dashed lines & proposed with solid lines).
 - h** Drainage plans with calculations, drainage devices, the location odrainage to, from and across the site.
 - i** Utility plans, if utilities are being installed
 - j** Erosion control plans
 - k** Soils report
 - l** Haul route as identified and approved by the Transportation Dept.
 - m** Wheel cleaning area per 18.20.210 of the SLC ordinances
- 3** All grading over 5,000 cubic yards shall require professional engineering and be designated as "Engineered Grading"
- 4** Separate plans to be submitted to SLC Public Utilities for review. They are located at 1530 South West Temple or phone 801-483-6727

The fee for a site development permit is \$248.00 for the 1st acre & \$61.00 each additional acre.
