

# 1300 East Waterline Replacement and Sewer Rehabilitation Project

A water replacement and sewer rehabilitation project along 1300 East from 1300 South to 2100 South is scheduled to begin in spring 2018, complete by winter 2018.

## 1300 East Waterline Replacement and Sewer Rehabilitation Project Quick Facts

What: Waterline replacement will replace the two waterlines in 1300 East. The new pipes will provide

> more capacity and increased reliability throughout the area. Sewer rehabilitation construction will take place to repair the sewer system. Impact of the project will be minimized using a

method known as "cured-in-place pipe," reducing the amount of excavation.

Where: 1300 East from 1300 South to 2100 South

When: Spring to winter 2018

Why: Salt Lake City is making improvements to the existing infrastructure and rehabilitating the water

and sewer systems to maintain service in the area.

## **Businesses/Residents Should Expect:**

• Notification prior to road closures

- Continued water and sewer services minimal interruptions are anticipated
- Maintained access to businesses and residences with only brief interruptions
- Some parking restrictions
- Open pits for waterline replacement along 1300 East
- Plated access over trenches to businesses and residences.

### **Project Benefits Include:**

- Increased capacity and reliability for the culinary water system
- Cured-in-place pipe repair expediting the construction schedule compared to full pipe replacement
- Extending the life of the sewer line while repairing existing defects
