ISSUE AT-A-GLANCE

The Administration has submitted eight grant applications. In an effort to ensure that the City Council, Council staff and the public has adequate opportunity to see and comment on them, the grant application notifications will be included in the Council meeting agendas under Public Hearings. There won't be a set date since this is not a required hearing.

4. School-Age Program Grant 2020 Utah Department of Workforce Services (UDWS) | Utah Office of Child Care <u>(Liberty Park)</u>

Purpose/Goal of the Grant: If awarded, the grant monies will be used to fund the expansion of the Liberty Park YouthCity childcare programming hours for the current group of 18 youth participants. Costs associated with the expansion of hours will be funded by the grant. Childcare is provided Monday thru Friday, seven hours a day, over the eight months of the school year and will now expand the ages of the youth to include children K-6th grade. Current hours of operation at this facility are 7:45 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. This proposal will expand childcare hours to 5:30 p.m. These grant funds are for expansion of program hours, not additional program sites.

Grant Amount: Maximum of \$9,800 per month during the 2020-21 school year **Requested by:** Department of Public Services, Division of Youth and Family **Funding Agency:** Utah Department of Workforce Services **Match Requirement**: A match is not required.

Wages and benefits for the five positions to serve one group of up to 18 youth from 2:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday thru Friday over eight months of the school year 2020-2021 will be funded through the UDWS Afterschool Match Partnership Grant 2020-2021 awarded in 2019.
