Although most City fees are shown, this consolidated fee schedule does not show penalties, such as fines and late fees; court fees; credit card processing fees; or fees required by a city contract, such as concession and franchise fees. It also may not show fees authorized by administrative rules or a general delegation of authority. The City intends that future versions of this document will show such fees.
