<u>Consideration of Proposed Demolition at 837 East Sherman Avenue</u> (Case No. HAZE2012-02963; Jacqueline Panko) City Council District Five

- 1. Address: 837 East Sherman Avenue. The structure to be demolished is a single-family dwelling. The owner of the property, Jackie Panko, is requesting demolition approval. The proposed post demolition use of the property has not been determined at this time.
- 2. Description of property and structure: The building has been damaged by a fire and is in disrepair. The structure is a one story frame building. The property is .14 acres in size.
