COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT OPEN HOUSE - Residents Invited to Submit Comments on Housing and Community Development Needs

Salt Lake City's Housing and Neighborhood Development Division invites residents to participate in a public open house to learn about and help prioritize 2015-16 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding requests.

Each year Salt Lake City receives CDBG and ESG grant funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The primary objective of CDBG funds is to develop viable urban communities by creating suitable living environments, providing decent housing, or creating economic opportunities—principally for low and moderate income persons. ESG funds are used to assist individuals and families in regaining housing stability after experiencing a housing or homelessness crisis.

The City is currently determining the best way to allocate these funds through an extensive review process of the applications submitted to the City. The Open House will provide an opportunity for the public to review applications for funding, speak with the applicants, and provide comment, if desired.
