Arts, Culture, and Events (ACE) Fund



UDOT I-15 Comment Period Now Open

The Utah Department of Transportation is now seeking feedback from those who use the I-15 corridor on their Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) outlining proposed options for an expansion of I-15.

The 30-day comment period for the I-15 Draft EIS runs through December 16th. If you are curious about the options presented, UDOT has hosted and recorded virtual open houses answering common public questions that are now available to view on their website.
