The Utah Department of Health (UDOH) Environmental Epidemiology Program (EEP), at the request of the Salt Lake Valley Health Department (SLVHD), has finalized a Public Health Assessment evaluating certain chemicals found in crude oil and the risk to public health following the June 2010 oil leak into Red Butte Creek.

You are invited to attend a public meeting about the assessment's findings:
