2. Land owner: The property owner(s) are engaged and willing to conserve the property and enter into negotiations with Salt Lake City Corporation.
3. Open Space Conservation Values: Salt Lake City protects lands that provide multiple public benefits. Check any of the following that apply to your project:

Adjacent to or expands existing open space or protected land

Scenic views

Bonneville Shoreline Trail or Bench

Wildlife or migratory habitat

Archeological or historical features

Unique geological features

Included in local or regional open space planning document

Riparian habitat

Rare, endangered, sensitive or critical species

Surface or subsurface water

Great Salt Lake Shoreline

Watershed

Local trail/trailhead

Wetland

Jordan River

Unique or native vegetation

Provides passive recreation

Area lacking open space

4. Land acquisition and conservation easement: Open space funds can not be used for restoration, mitigation, improvements, park development or non-historic structures.
5. Clear title. The appropriate title and ownership appear to be free of obvious problems.
