

TREE PROTECTION REQUIREMENTS

Establishing a Tree Protection Zone (TPZ)

See Tree Protection and Preservation Policy for fence alignment.

The width/diameter of the fenced area = 2' per inch of DBH (Diameter at Breast Height). 24" DBH = 48' fence width/diameter); for trees located in a park strip, surround the entire unpaved strip from top of curb to sidewalk

Notes:

1 - See Urban Forestry Tree Protection and Preservation Policy for additional tree protection requirements.

2 - Provide each tree with 20 gallons of water, twice weekly.

3 - No pruning shall be performed except by an approved arborist under an issued permit.

4 - No equipment shall operate inside the protective fencing, including during fence installation and removal.
