Reservation Policy

All Fees are Non-Refundable

Dates, times or facilities may be changed prior to reservation date (based on availability during the 2022 reservation season) by calling (801)-535-7860.

It is **your responsibility** to bring a copy of your permit/receipt to the park on your reservation day. Your permit/receipt is **required** for enforcement of your reservation.

- Smoking
- Loud Music
- Dunking Booths
- Water Slides
- Slip and Slides
- Water Balloons
- Piñatas
- Confetti
- Animal Rides or Petting
 Zoos
- Rock Climbing Walls
- Open Fires (including fire pits/fire places)
- Ground Stakes
- Rotisserie Grill (Grease)
- Items attached to Trees

Vehicles

Vehicles are <u>not allowed</u> on the grass.

Vehicles <u>must</u> be parked in designated parking spots.

If you park on the grass, you will be charged additional fees.

Pavilion Power

<u>Limited Power</u> is available in the pavilions (15 amps, enough to run only one small appliance)

Water

<u>No Water</u> is supplied for reservation usage.

The only source of running water in SLC Parks are drinking fountains.

Amplified Sound/Music

Amplified sound must be kept at a volume that does not leave the perimeter of your pavilion.

Violation of Salt Lake City's Noise Ordinance may result in fines.

Please be respectful of others!

Clean Up and Recycle

Before leaving the park, please pick up all litter and debris from your pavilion area.

Failure to pick up trash can result in additional fees.

Many parks have recycling containers for your use.

Please recycle when possible.

Recreation Kits

Includes 2 softballs, 2 bats, 1 volleyball, 1 volleyball net, 1 football, 1 soccer ball and a set of horseshoes.

<u>\$15 plus tax</u>

Kits must be paid for and picked up from the Public Lands
Building Monday-Friday
between 7:30 am - 3:45 pm
before or the day of your
reservation.

Kits must be returned the first business day after your reservation.



Other Events

Special Events

Activities such as selling to the public, serving food to the public and holding events such as races, walks or fundraisers are considered special events.

Special events will be booked through the SLC Events Office.
