ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
RIO GRANDE COMMUNITY COUNCIL

The undersigned natural person, being at least twenty one years or more, acting as  
incorporator under the Utah Non-Profit Corporation and Cooperative Association Act, Utah Code  
Ann. §§ 16-5-1 et seq. (the "Code"), adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:



ARTICLE I

NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the Corporation (hereinafter called the "Council") is RIO GRANDE  
COMMUNITY COUNCIL.

ARTICLE II

DURATION OF CORPORATION

The Council shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III

CORPORATE PURPOSES

The Council is organized as a community and neighborhood organization formed pursuant  
to Salt Lake City Ordinance No. 63 of 1990, or a corresponding section of any future Salt Lake City  
ordinance. The character of affairs which the Council intends actually to conduct in the State of  
Utah is to serve as a community and neighborhood organization representing the interests and  
expressing the concerns of property owners and tenants, residents, and business owners and operators  
within the boundaries established from time to time by the Salt Lake City Council pursuant to  
petitions filed with the Salt Lake City Council. The Council shall also have such other powers as  
are authorized for non-profit corporations from time to time under the Code.

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## **ARTICLE IV**

### **MEMBERS**

The Council shall have one or more classes of members, and the designation of such class or classes, the manner of election or appointment, the qualifications and rights of the members of each class and any provisions for termination or forfeiture of membership shall be set forth in the Bylaws of the Council.

## **ARTICLE V**

### **BYLAWS**

The Trustees of the Council may adopt Bylaws which are not inconsistent with law or with these Articles for the regulation and management of the affairs of the Council. The Bylaws may be amended from time to time or repealed pursuant to law.

## **ARTICLE VI**

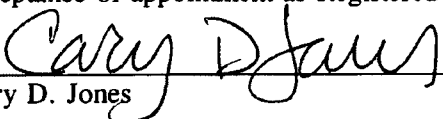
