ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF THE

WESTSIDE COMMUNITY COUNCIL CORPORATION

1. The name of this Corporation shall be the Westside Community Council Corporation.
2. This Corporation shall have perpetual existence.
3. This Corporation is organized as a non-profit organization, and shall not issue capital stock.
4. This Corporation shall have an initial governing board of five members.

7. The purpose of this Corporation shall be:

1. Study of community needs and resources
2. Cooperative planning and coordination for health and welfare services
3. Promotion of social improvements
4. And to, in any way, work with groups or individuals, governmental units, or corporation to advance or promote improvements that shall be deemed in the best interest of the citizens of the Westside of Salt Lake City, Utah.

8. This Corporation, at the discretion of its membership or Board of Directors, may solicit and receive monies, real and personal property, and other assets. It may enter into contractual agreements with federal, state or other governmental units or private organizations or individuals.

9. The initial office of this Corporation shall be located at
614 Emery Street, Salt Lake City, Utah.
10. The name and address of the authorized agent of this Corporation
shall be: Richard Carman, 614 Emery Street, Salt Lake City, Utah.
11. This Corporation shall grant membership to organizations and individuals
who subscribe to the purpose and policy of the Corporation, upon approval
by the Board of Directors and payment of dues.
Each organization becoming a member shall appoint two delegates to
represent it.
12. The officers, who must be members of this Corporation, shall be a
President, 1st Vice-President and 2nd Vice-President and a Secretary-
Treasurer, who shall be elected by the membership at the annual meeting
to serve for two years, and shall take office immediately after being
elected and duly qualified. Election shall be such that the President
and Secretary-Treasurer shall be elected in one year, and the other
officers in alternate years. These officers shall comprise the
executive committee of the Board of Directors. All officers shall be
eligible for re-election.
13. The annual meeting of this Corporation shall be held the third Thursday
of each January at 1050 West 5th South, Salt Lake City, Utah, or other
location in Salt Lake City as set forth by the Board of Directors. If
this meeting is held any place other than the afore mentioned address,
all members shall be notified at least 15 and not more than 30 days in
advance of said annual meeting. The meeting will be held at 8:00 p.m.
Rocky Mountain time.
14. The business of the organization shall be conducted according to the
articles and by-laws of the Corporation.
15. The articles and by-laws of this Corporation may be amended by a two-
thirds vote of the voting members present at any general membership
meeting.

17. In the event of liquidation of this Corporation, it shall be liquidated in accordance with Section 501 of the Federal Internal Revenue Code.
