This Corporation shall grant membership to organizations and individuals who subscribe to the purpose and policy of the Corporation, upon approval by the Board of Directors and payment of dues. Each organization becoming a member shall appoint two delegates to represent it.

The officers, who must be members of this Corporation, shall be a President, 1st Vice-President and 2nd Vice-President and a Secretary-Treasurer, who shall be elected by the membership at the annual meeting to serve for two years, and shall take office immediately after being elected and duly qualified. Election shall be such that the President and Secretary-Treasurer shall be elected in one year, and the other officers in alternate years. These officers shall comprise the executive committee of the Board of Directors. All officers shall be eligible for re-election.

The annual meeting of this Corporation shall be held the third Thursday of each January at 1050 West 5th South, Salt Lake City, Utah, or other location in Salt Lake City as set forth by the Board of Directors. If this meeting is held any place other than the afore mentioned address, all members shall be notified at least 15 and not more than 30 days in advance of said annual meeting. The meeting will be held at 8:00 p.m. Rocky Mountain time.

- 15. The articles and by-laws of this Corporation may be amended by a twothirds vote of the voting members present at any general membership meeting.
