Public Meeting Guidelines

Please observe guidelines established to create a safe, respectful environment. A safe, respectful environment allows a meeting to be conducted in an orderly manner, free from intimidation and threats to safety. We welcome all to attend.

Please be mindful and keep comments free of discriminatory language referring to a person or group based on their religion, ethnicity, nationality, race, color, descent, gender, sexual orientation, disability, age or other gender identity factor. Items or comments that disrupt the meeting, intimidate other participants or that may cause safety concerns are not allowed.

The Commission may accept public comment when listed on the agenda. Please consider the following when a public comment period has been identified.

- The conducting Commissioner will call upon each attendee in the order of their arrival
- Attendees may be provided one or two minutes of time, determined by the number of attendees and the time available from the Commission. *Please observe the time limit stated at the beginning of the public comment period so everyone may have a chance to speak.*
- Upon hearing your name –
 - if you do not wish to speak, please state you are here to listen, and the meeting moderator will mute your microphone and move to the next person
 - if you do wish to speak, please state your name and the topic of your comment
- People cannot combine their time so that one person may speak longer than another
