ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CENTRAL EAST NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL

ARTICLE I

The name of the non-profit corporation shall be:

CENTRAL EAST NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL

ARTICLE II

The period of duration of the corporation shall continue perpetually unless sooner terminated according to law.

ARTICLE III

The objects, purposes and scope of the Corporation shall be as follows:

- (a) It is organized as a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Utah.
- (b) To combat neighborhood and community wide deterioration
- (c) To implement methods to upgrade and beautify the area and and change the incompatible land uses.
- (d) To restore, rehabilitate, or rebuild housing for all residents in the community.
- (e) To form a network of communication and information pertaining to significant impact of large complexes, highways, zoning, and school closures or new schools in the community.
- (f) To preserve and improve as a residential area desirable for family living those suitable areas in the Council community which bounds 13th East on the east, 7th East on the west, South Temple on the north and 13th South on the south.
- (g) To receive, invest and disburse funds and to hold property for its purposes.
- (h) To receive gifts and contributions or real and personal property from the Unites States of America or any agency thereof, from the State of Utah or any subdivision or agency thereof, or from any charitable organization, person, firm or corporation for use in furthering its purposes.

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- (i) To do all of the aforesaid without contemplation of any pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof so that no part of the net earnings or property any any kind belonging to this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private shareholder, member or individual.
- (j) The foregoing enumeration of specific purposes and objects shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of the corporation but shall be in furtherance of and in addition to the general powers conferred by the Utah Non-profit Corporation and Cooperative Association Act and by all other laws in the State of Utah, all of which powers this non-profit corporation shall have.

ARTICLE IV

The corporation shall have members and membership shall be open to all persons residing or owning property in that area of Salt Lake City as described above, upon such terms and conditions as shall be provided by the By-Laws of the Corporation. Members shall not be individually or personally liable for the debts and obligations of the Corporation.

ARTICLE V

No shares of stock will be issued by the Corporation and none will be required for membership.

ARTICLE VI

The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Chairman, Vice Chairman and Secretary, each of whom shall be elected by the Association and chosen from its membership. Such other officers as may be deemed necessary may be elected or appointed by the Association.

Officers of the Association shall be elected annually by the Association.

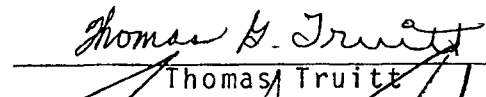

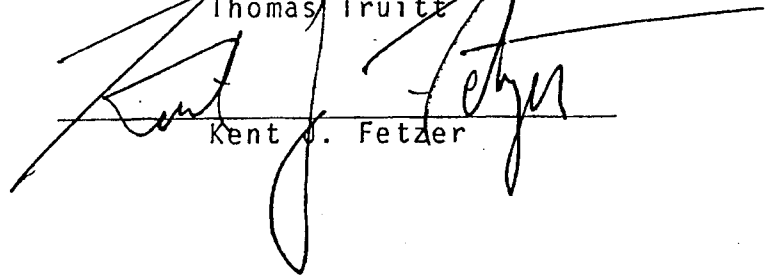

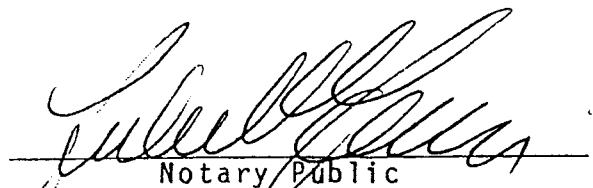
