2017 Municipal Election

General Information

- Ballots will be mailed July 25, 2017 for the Primary Election held on August 15, 2017 and October 17, 2017 for the General Election held on November 7, 2017.
- Military and Overseas ballot mailing will be June 30, 2017 for the Primary Election and September 22, 2017 for the General Election.
- Ballots will include a postage paid return envelope.
- Ballots must be postmarked the Monday before Election Day.
- There will be ballot drop-box locations at The Salt Lake County Government Center, 2001 South State Street, Suite S1-200; The City and County Building, 451 South State Street; The River's Bend Senior Center, 1300 West 300 North; and at designated [Vote Centers](#) throughout the County.
- Voters who need assistance or did not receive a ballot, may vote at any of the one of the designated Vote Centers on Election Day.
