Begins this Summer in SLC

**Expect an official ballot twice
this year in your mailbox!**



To increase voter participation, City leaders have approved a major change for this year's Municipal Election voting process. For the Primary and General Elections in 2015, all registered voters in Salt Lake City will receive a ballot in the mail.

- Ballots will be mailed 28 days before the August 11 Primary Election and again 28 days before the November 3 General Election.
 - If you have moved, contact the Salt Lake County Election Division by email at got-vote@slco.org or (385) 468-7400 to update your address to ensure you receive a ballot.
 - Ballot drop box locations will be available at the Salt Lake City and County Building and the Salt Lake County Government Center.
 - Voters who need accommodations for disabilities, misplaced, or did not receive a ballot; may cast a ballot at any of the four Vote Centers from 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. on Primary & General Election Day.
