To reduce our environmental impact and extend the life of our landfill, Mayor Ralph Becker and the Salt Lake City Council have set a goal to divert 50% of the waste stream by 2015.

Residents are allowed to opt out of having a blue curbside recycling container, however city ordinance does not allow you to place recyclable items such as paper, plastic, cardboard, and aluminum in a city-issued garbage container or neighborhood cleanup pile. By signing this form, the property owner agrees that recyclable material will be delivered to a recycling facility.

Opting out of the curbside recycling program will not change your collection service fee. There is one waste collection service fee which includes the cost of providing all waste and recycling services: weekly garbage, weekly yard waste, weekly curbside recycling, neighborhood cleanup, and approximately 20 glass drop-off sites throughout the city.
