LEAVES-ONLY BIN COLLECTION



Residents can request an additional curbside compost bin for surplus leaves during the fall months.

HOLIDAY TREE COLLECTION



Holiday trees that cannot fit into your curbside compost bin are collected over two weeks every January. During this time, residents can place their tree at the curb or in their curbside compost bin for collection.

NEIGHBORHOOD CLEANUP



Every year a Neighborhood Cleanup day is provided to each city household. Cleanup items accepted include bulky waste, such as branches, stumps and furniture. Residents are given notification by mail at least one month before their collection day.

Drop-off Specialty Items

Household Hazardous Waste & Electronic Waste (e-waste)

Household Hazardous Waste and Electronic Waste (e-waste) should be disposed of at the Salt Lake County Hazardous Waste Recycling Facility at 6030 West California Avenue.



Pharmaceutical Waste

Pharmaceutical waste should be disposed of at one of the Salt Lake City Police Stations. Do not flush down sink or toilet.

Fluorescent Light Tubes & CFLs

Fluorescent light tubes and CFLs can be dropped off at your nearest Salt Lake County Library, the Salt Lake City-County Building or the Main Library downtown.

Curbside Service Details

Put out bins on your collection day by

7am

Place your bins at least

3ft

from mailboxes, vehicles, fire hydrants, trees & other bins.

Consider setting your bin out only when it is at least

3/4 full

Do not overfill your bins. If the lid won't close, it won't be picked up.

Remember that items stacked outside of bins will not be collected.

SERVICE: Weekly	COST: No extra charge, included in garbage fee	WHERE IT GOES: Processed into wood chips, mulch & compost, which is available for purchase at the Landfill.

Curbside GARBAGE

SERVICE: Weekly	COST: 40-gal = \$13.75/mo 60-gal = \$17.75/mo 90-gal = \$21.00/mo	WHERE IT GOES: Landfill. Even newspaper, which has a relatively fast decomposition rate, can last over 50 years when landfilled.

- Chemicals
 - Electronics
 - Compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs)
 - Computers
 - Hazardous waste (paint, motor oil, pesticides, herbicides)
 - Monitors
 - Televisions
 - Recyclables
 - Yard Waste
 - Limit concrete, sod, dirt, and rocks to less than 1/3 of the contents due to weight limitations



Curbside GLASS Recycling

SERVICE: Monthly, optional	COST: \$7/month, added to water bill	WHERE IT GOES: A local facility, where it is crushed, cleaned & sorted by color & size. End markets include fiberglass insulation, cement & sandblasting media, water filtration, pavement, & bottle manufacturing.
